Apolistó de silicona Scarban - Elástico y Ligero

Descripción del producto

El apóstolo de silicona Scarban es una tecnología probada para el tratamiento de cicatrices (hipertroficas y queloides) y para prevenir el desarrollo de cicatrices anormales, postoperatorias o traumáticas.

El apóstolo de silicona es adhesivo (con excepción de la silicona líquida), lavable, y apto para uso en la piel.

- Scarban Silicone Cleaning Soap es un producto limpiador para los apóstolos de silicona.

Composición

- Caja de tejido: poliamida, elastano

- Siliconas: grado médico

Propiedades

- Los apóstolos de silicona Scarban tienen que las cicatrices se vuelvan más suaves, más suaves y más delgadas, y ayudan a reducir las molestias (riesgo persistente, tirantez de la cicatriz, pior, movilidad restringida) en articulaciones, incomodidad y molestias cosmeticas.

- El apóstolo de silicona Scarban tiene que la piel que tiene resultado una mayor hidratación de la piel (epidérmica).

- La mayor hidratación acelera la recuperación del tejido dañado de la piel y ayuda a reducir las molestias.

- Los apóstolos de silicona Scarban tienen que proporcionar protección UV de forma estandar (al menos 95 % UV bloqueo).

Indicaciones/ámbitos de aplicación

Los apóstolos de silicona Scarban son aptos para:

- Tanto cicatrices antiguas como nuevas

- Túnicas de edades

- El tratamiento y la prevención de cicatrices anormales (hipertroficas y queloides)

- El tratamiento y la prevención de quemasadoras

- El tratamiento y la prevención de cicatrices quirúrgicas

- Levantar debajo de la ropa y terapia de compresión

- El tratamiento de problemas persistentes causados por la cicatriz (riesgo persistente, tirantez de la cicatriz, pior, movilidad restringida) en articulaciones, incomodidad y molestias cosmeticas.

Modo de empleo apóstolo de silicona Scarban

(verse más abajo para el modo de empleo del quemado y el dedo)

- Para un resultado óptimo, conviene a utilizar el tratamiento de silicona Scarban directamente sobre la piel de la cicatriz o de la herida (después de retirarse los puntos y desaparecer eventualmente costuras).

- Se recomienda gradualmente el uso del tratamiento de silicona Scarban hasta obtener un contenido suficiente para un tratamiento de alrededor de 4 a 8 semanas.

- Para el mejor resultado se recomienda aplicar apóstolo de silicona Scarban directamente sobre la piel.

- Si es necesario, el apóstolo de silicona Scarban puede cortarse en el tamaño adecuado (fig. 1).

- Para el mejor resultado de la cicatriz con el apóstolo de silicona, se recomienda eliminar el velo adherido de la zona de la cicatriz.

- Limpiar y seguir bien las anteriores de aplicar el apóstolo de silicona Scarban en la piel.

- Retirar la lámina protectora del dero del apóstolo de silicona (fig. 3) y pegue la silicona Scarban en la cicatriz (fig. 4).

- Si es necesario, la silicona Scarban puede fijarse con un apóstolo adhesivo o flexible (fig. 5).

- Después de retirar el apóstolo de silicona, la piel puede tratarse con una crema hidratante.

Modo de empleo apóstolo de silicona Scarban: Guante y Dedo

El apóstolo de silicona Scarban se lleva si se forma una cicatriz en la mano.

- Para ponerse el guante, primero tiene que doblarse hacia fuera el puño del guante. Esto evita que el puno de dedos se despegue de la mano.

- Para poder deslizar la mano fácilmente en el guante, es necesario, prevenir tirantez de la mano, ya sea a través de la mano o la muñeca.

- Una vez que se ha puesto el guante, se debe aplicar el apóstolo de silicona Scarban en la mano.

- Despues de ponerse el guante, desabrochar el dedo del guante.

Modo de empleo apóstolo de silicona Scarban: Dedo











El apóstolo de silicona Scarban se lleva si se forma una cicatriz en el dedo.

- Determinar primero la longitud necesaria de apóstolo de silicona.

- Colocar para ello el dedo en el apóstolo. En la parte lateral del apóstolo se coloca la silicona Scarban, que se fija con el apóstolo de silicona Scarban que se coloca en el dedo inferior hasta la marca colorada donde se encuentra el extremo del dedo.

- Una vez que se coloca arrededor del dedo el apóstolo, se debe aplicar la silicona Scarban.

- Para poder deslizar el dedo fácilmente en el apóstolo, si es necesario,

Scarban silicone sheets - Elastico and Light

Product Description

- Scarban silicone sheets are a proven technology for treating scars (hypertrophic and keloid) and preventing abnormal scar development after surgery or an injury. Scarban silicone sheet is self-adhesive (with the exception of the silicone glove and finger), washable, and can be used for a long period of time.

- Scarban Silicone Cleaning Soap is a cleaning agent for silicone sheets.

Composition

- Textile layer: polyamide, elastane
- Medical grade silicones

Properties

- Scarban silicone sheets ensure that scars become flatter, smoother, and thinner and reduce complaints (like persistent redness, pulling of the scar, itching, restriction of points movement, discomfort and cosmetic concerns) after being washed.

- Scarban silicone sheets provide a semi-occlusive (covering) layer on top of the skin, which results in increased hydration of the skin (epidermis). This increased hydration ensures that the damaged scar recovers more quickly than functional objections (complaints) caused by the scar.

- Scarban silicone sheets provide UV protection as standard (at least 95% UV blocker).

Indications/applications

- Scarban silicone sheets are suitable for:
- both old and new scars
- all skin types
- all ages
- treatment and prevention of abnormal scars (hypertrophic and keloid)
- the removal of burns
- treatment of surgical scars
- use under clothing and in compression therapy
- treatment of persistent functional complaints caused by the scar (persistent redness, pulling of the scar, itching, restriction of joint movement, discomfort and cosmetic concerns)

Instructions for use - Scarban silicone sheets:

(For maintenance of glove and finger see below)

- It is essential to wash the Scarban silicone sheets properly, on a daily basis.

- Rub the silicone sheet with a few drops of Scarban Silicone Cleaning Soap or a neutral soap (fig. 6).

- Rinse as much dirt as possible with soap and lukewarm water.

- Rinse the silicone sheet thoroughly under lukewarm running water.

- After contact with soap and water, the silicone sheet will no longer be adhesive and it will roll up (fig. 8).

- Leave the silicone sheet to dry on a clean, dry surface, with the sticky side facing upwards (fig. 8).

- Wash the silicone sheet off again with water.

- Once the silicone sheet is dry, roll it up and store it in a zip lock bag.

- Use the silicone sheet only after it has completely dried.

- Trim edges of silicone sheets that are not long enough.

- Use Scarban silicone sheets as glove and finger when it has been cleaned.
